

Meet Hints 2008

What Can I Bring?

1. Bring lawn chairs/umbrella/poncho
2. bug spray /suntan lotion/towels/ warm dry clothes for swimmers
3. permanent marker to write events on your swimmers hand if you want
4. cash for concessions and heat sheet
5. cooler if you desire

When is warm ups?

Home meets: Cedar Creek warms up first, at 5:00

Away meets: Cedar Creek warms up second, at 5:30

When do I do my volunteer position?

First shift: Be prepared for a 6:00 – approximately 7:30/8:00 shift (event 38)

Second shift: Be prepared any time after 7:30 until the end of the meet (10:00ish)

What if I cannot make a meet?

Please see the electronic form available on the web sight for any anticipated missed meets. A notice of 5 days is best so we do not enter your child into a meet they cannot attend. If we do not have ample notice, another child may miss an opportunity to swim where your child had been scheduled. In addition, be prepared to tell us what parent volunteer you have invited to do your assigned job should you have one for that particular meet. **Please do not leave us to find your replacement at the last minute! .**

What if it is raining or there is a prediction of a storm?

Go to all meets, even in inclement weather! Often meets are simply delayed rather than canceled! Please stay in an area (ex: your car) where you can be advised on what to do. Do not assume a meet is cancelled and leave.

Will there be a morning practice following a late night swim meet?

Often we do a “fun swim” where all swimmers receive their earned ribbons following a swim meet. This may not happen each time this season as we have more meets scheduled for one month than normal. Please listen to Coach Dave’s advice during the swim meet. Look for an email in the morning

How can I tell if my child is a candidate for the County Swim Meet in July?

Feel free to check the Gwinnett County Swim League web sight for a listing of the top swimmers in each event. This is updated following each meet. Remember, the top 50 swimmers available for the county meet will be accepted. If you still have a doubt, ask a coach towards the latter part of the season!

Will my child earn a reward at the end of the season?

Participation in at least 3 meets is required to earn the reward.
